China: DaDong

Those familiar with the eternal “who has the best Peking duck in Beijing” debate are well aware of Dong Zhenxiang, aka Da Dong, widely considered one of China’s most influential chefs. Thankfully, lovers of the dish will no longer have to venture all the way to Asia to taste his cooking, as he’s announced the opening of his first U.S.–based restaurant, slated to open in New York in March 2017. Located just west of the heart of Times Square, the sprawling two story spot will occupy 12,932 square feet of the The Cube Building.
