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We've picked the best new additions to New York City's bar and restaurant scenes for December 2017.

DaDong

[DaDong](#), perhaps the world's best-known place to get roast peking duck, has finally come to New York. This location joins 10 DaDongs in Beijing, four in Shanghai, and two in Chengdu. The NYC branch is every bit as palatial as its Chinese brethren, occupying 17,500 square feet over two floors, with an expansive terrace. The highlight, naturally, is the duck—whole or half carved tableside and served with soft wrappers, crispy buns, and sauces. But there are more than 80 other items on the expansive menu, including squid ink soup with tofu threads and black truffle; sweet and sour pork ribs with powdered sugar, and braised sea cucumber with young wheat grains and leeks.
